

WHY MUSIC?

COGNITIVE BENEFITS

When we play an instrument, our brain enters a heightened state of concentration, which enhances our ability to focus.

Learning to read music stimulates left brain function. Reading notes on a staff enhances reading comprehension skills, and learning rhythm via time signatures promotes enhanced ability to understand and perform mathematical equations.



MOTOR SKILL ENHANCEMENT

Manual Dexterity is refined by the practice and playing of instruments. Playing with two hands provides bilateral stimulation and leads to refinement in motor skills.

Performing on stage gives us the opportunity to practice and refine large motor skills.

CREATIVITY

Playing music naturally evokes an emotional state of being.

Because music has no boundaries, it provides a venue for limitless selfexpression.

SOCIAL SKILLS

Playing and performing music with others provides an opportunity to develop our social skills.

Communicating creatively with other players helps translate into proactive communicating and positive problem solving with the other people in our lives.
